All India Weather Inference (NIGHT)

- ◆ The Western Disturbance as a cyclonic circulation over east Afghanistan & adjoining Pakistan between 3.1 & 3.6 km above mean sea level persists.
- ◆ The northwest-southeast trough in westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along 60° E to the north of latitude 30° N persists.
- ◆ The induced cyclonic circulation over Pakistan and adjoining West Rajasthan extending upto 1.5 Km above mean sea level persists.
- ◆ The cyclonic circulation over southwest Madhya Pradesh and adjoining Vidarbha at 0.9 km above mean sea level persists.
- ◆ The trough at 0.9 km above mean sea level from South Interior Karnataka to above cyclonic circulation over southwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining Vidarbha across North Interior Karnataka and Marathwada persists.
- ◆ The cyclonic circulation over south coastal Tamilnadu & neighbourhood extending upto 1.5 km above mean sea level persists.
- ◆ The cyclonic circulation at 0.9 km above mean sea level over West Bengal and adjoining Bangladesh persists.
