Subject: Wet spell over Western Himalayan Region and adjoining plains of Northwest India during 06<sup>th-</sup>08<sup>th</sup> March, 2021.

### Meteorological analysis:

♦ A fresh Western Disturbance is very likely to affect Western Himalayan Region from the night of 05th March and adjoining plains of Northwest India from the night of 06th March. Under its influence:

### a) Precipitation Forecast & Warning:

(i) Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/snowfall very likely over Western Himalayan Region (Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand) during **06<sup>th</sup>-07<sup>th</sup> March. Snowfall** is likely over higher reaches of above regions.

**Isolated heavy rainfall/snowfall** very likely over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad on **06<sup>th</sup> & 07<sup>th</sup>** and over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on **07<sup>th</sup> March.** 

Thunderstorm with lightning & hail is very likely at isolated places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 06<sup>th</sup> & 07<sup>th</sup> March.

(ii) Isolated light rain/drizzle very likely over Punjab on 06<sup>th</sup> & 07<sup>th</sup> and over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and West Uttar Pradesh on 07<sup>th</sup> March.

**Thunderstorm with lightning & hail** also very likely at isolated places over Punjab and north Haryana & Chandigarh and **thunderstorm with lightning** at isolated places over West Uttar Pradesh on **07<sup>th</sup> March**.


# b) Maximum Temperature Forecast over Northwest India:


Maximum temperatures likely to remain between 28-33 <sup>o</sup>C over most parts of Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi and West Uttar Pradesh during next 4-5 days. It is likely to fall by 3-4 <sup>o</sup>C on 7<sup>th</sup> March due to impact of likely wet spell over these areas.
