Subject: Regarding further progress of monsoon over remaining parts of northwest India

- **Southwest Monsoon has so far advanced into entire Peninsular, east central and east and northeastern India and some parts of northwest India in association with active monsoon circulations and formation of a low pressure area without any hiatus. However due to approaching of mid-latitude westerlies winds further progress of monsoon over remaining parts of northwest India is likely to be slow. The progress of monsoon is being monitored continuously and further update will be provided on daily basis.**

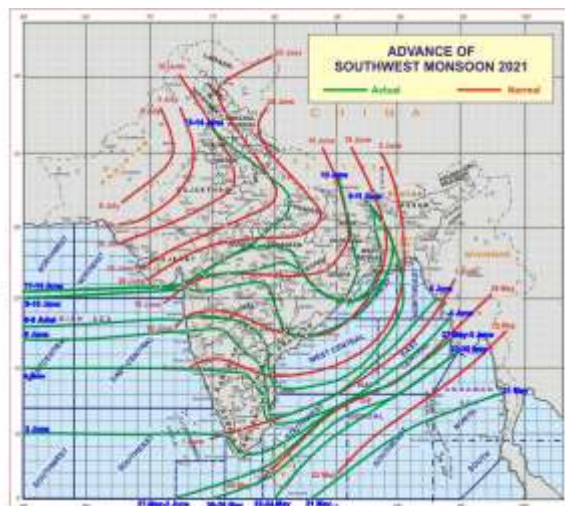


Fig 1: Northern Limit of the southwest Monsoon 2021 as on 14th June 2021

- **The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) passes through lat. 20.5°N/ Long. 60°E, Diu, Surat, Nandurbar, Bhopal, Nowgong, Hamirpur, Barabanki, Bareilly, Saharanpur, Ambala and Amritsar (refer Fig 1 for Northern Limit of the southwest Monsoon 2021 as on 14th June 2021).**
