<u>Subject:</u> (i) Isolated heavy rainfall very likely to continue over East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat state during next 5 days.

- (ii) Isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha till 22<sup>nd</sup> September.
- (iii) A fresh spell of heavy rainfall likely over Odisha from 25<sup>th</sup> September and Gangetic West Bengal from 26<sup>th</sup> September.
- Rainfall Amount recorded (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today) (7 cm or more): Given at annexure.

#### **Weather Systems:**

- ✓ Monsoon trough lies to the south of its normal position and likely to remain so during next 5 days.
- ✓ A Low Pressure Area lies over southeast Jharkhand & neighbourhood with the associated cyclonic circulation extends upto middle tropospheric levels. It is likely to weaken gradually during next 24 hours and move west-northwestwards as a cyclonic circulation across north Chhattisgarh & north Madhya Pradesh during subsequent 3 days.
- ✓ A cyclonic circulation lies over East Rajasthan & neighbourhood at lower tropospheric levels and likely to persist during next 2 days.
- ✓ A cyclonic circulation lies over Myanmar coast & adjoining Gulf of Martaban and extends upto mid-tropospheric levels. It is likely to move northwestwards and emerge into Northeast & adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal and under its influence, a Low Pressure Area is likely to form over the same region around 24th evening. Then it is likely to move west-northwestwards towards Odisha coast during the subsequent 48 hours.


#### **Weather forecast and Warning:**

i) Scattered to fairly widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy falls** very likely over Uttarakhand during 22<sup>nd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>; over East Uttar Pradesh during 22<sup>nd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> and over West Uttar Pradesh & Haryana on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2021.

- ii) Fairly widespread to widespread Rainfall with Isolated **heavy falls** are likely over Gangetic West Bengal & Odisha on  $22^{nd}$  September, 2021 and decrease in rainfall activity thereafter.
- iii) Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with Isolated **heavy falls** are likely over East Rajasthan & Gujarat Region during 22<sup>nd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> and over West Rajasthan on 22<sup>nd</sup> September. Isolated **very heavy falls** also very likely over Gujarat Region on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2021.
- iv) Fairly widespread to widespread Rainfall with Isolated **heavy falls** are likely over Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh till 24<sup>th</sup> September and over Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra & Marathawada till 23<sup>rd</sup> September and decrease thereafter.
- v) A cyclonic circulation lies over Myanmar coast & adjoining Gulf of Martaban and extends upto mid-tropospheric levels. It is likely to move northwestwards and emerge into Northeast & adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal and under its influence, **a Low Pressure Area** is likely to form over the same region around 24th evening. Then it is likely to move west-northwestwards towards Odisha coast during the subsequent 48 hours. Under its influence; a fresh spell of heavy rainfall likely over Odisha and adjoining areas from 25th September, 2021.

## EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to Very Heavy

Rainfall over Gujarat Region and Konkan & Goa on 21st September, 2021.

#### A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, inundation and water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

#### **B.** Action Suggested


- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

**Heavy Rain:** 64.5 to 115.5 mm; **Very Heavy Rain:** 115.6 to 204.4 mm; **Extremely Heavy Rain >** 204.4 mm.

- 3) **East India:** Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- 4) **Northeast India**: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
- 5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
