Press Release Date: 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2021 Time of Issue: 1330 hrs IST

<u>Subject:</u> (i) Isolated heavy rainfall very likely to continue over East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat state and north Konkan during next 5 days.

(ii) A fresh spell of heavy rainfall likely over Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal from 26<sup>th</sup> September.

Rainfall Amount recorded (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today) (7 cm or more): Given at annexure.

#### Weather Systems:

- ✓ Monsoon trough lies to the south of its normal position and likely to remain so during next 5 days.
- ✓ A cyclonic circulation lies over south Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood and extends upto middle tropospheric levels. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards across Madhya Pradesh during next 3 days.
- ✓ A cyclonic circulation lies over southwest Rajasthan & neighbourhood at lower tropospheric levels and likely to persist during next 2 days.
- ✓ A cyclonic circulation lies over Myanmar coast & adjoining Gulf of Martaban and extends upto middle tropospheric levels. It is likely to move northwestwards and emerge into Northeast & adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal. Under its influence, a Low Pressure Area is likely to form over the same region around 24<sup>th</sup> evening. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards towards Odisha coast during subsequent 48 hours.

#### Weather forecast and Warning:


i) Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy falls** very likely over East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat state, Konkan & Goa and Coastal Andhra Pradesh during next 5 days. **Isolated very heavy falls** is also likely over Gujarat Region on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>; Saurashtra & Kutch on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> and over Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

ii) Due to likely formation of Low Pressure Area over Northeast & adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal around 24th evening and its west-northwestwards movement, a fresh spell of heavy rainfall likely over Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal from 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.
iii Scattered to fairly widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls very likely over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana on today, the 23<sup>rd</sup> September. Isolated very heavy rainfall likely over Punjab on today, the 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2021.

iv) Rainfall activity is likely to increase over Kerala & Mahe with fairly widespread rainfall & isolated heavy falls from 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

**EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED due to Very Heavy Rainfall** over Punjab on 23<sup>rd</sup> September and over Gujarat Region on 23<sup>rd</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

#### A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, inundation and water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

#### **B. Action Suggested**

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

### Legends:

**Heavy Rain:** 64.5 to 115.5 mm; **Very Heavy Rain:** 115.6 to 204.4 mm; **Extremely Heavy Rain** > 204.4 mm.

#### Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:

2) Central India: West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.

3) **East India:** Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

4) **Northeast India:** Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.

6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
