# Subject:

- i) Light to moderate rainfall activity very likely to continue over Northeast & south peninsular India.
- ii) Heat wave condition likely over south Haryana, West Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

## Weather observed during past 24 hours:

- ✓ **Maximum Temperatures** (as on 24/03/2022) recorded **40-41°C** in many parts over Vidarbha and in isolated pockets over West Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Marathwada, Madhya Maharashtra, Rayalaseema and Telangana.
- ✓ The maximum temperatures were **above normal by 4-6°C** at a few places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab and west Uttar Pradesh: at isolated places over Jammu Division, West Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Haryana-Chandigarh, Assam & Meghalaya and south Gujarat region.
- ✓ Yesterday, No Heat Wave conditions observed in any part of the country.
- ✓ Heavy rainfall observed at isolated places over Kerala and Assam & Meghalaya.

### **Forecast & Warnings:**

- ✓ Under the influence of trough/wind discontinuity over south Peninsular India at lower tropospheric levels,
  - Light to moderate isolated/scattered rainfall very likely over Kerala-Mahe, Tamilnadu-Puducherry-Karaikal and Karnataka during next 5 days and over Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> March and over Telangana & Rayalaseema on 25<sup>th</sup> March.
  - Isolated light to moderate thunderstorm/lightning activity also very likely over Karnataka on 25<sup>th</sup> March, over Tamilnadu-Puducherry-Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.
  - Isolated heavy rainfall also likely over South Interior Karnataka & south Tamilnadu on 25<sup>th</sup> March and over Kerala-Mahe on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.
- ✓ Due to strong southwesterly winds from Bay of Bengal to northeastern states at lower tropospheric levels;
  - Light to moderate fairly widespread/widespread rainfall very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam-Meghalaya & Nagaland-Manipur-Mizoram-Tripura on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> and isolated light rainfall very likely over the region during 27<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> March.


- Isolated thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds over Northeast India on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.
- Isolated heavy rainfall also likely over Arunachal Pradesh & Assam-Meghalaya on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.

#### **Maximum Temperature and Heat Wave conditions Forecast:**

- ✓ No significant change in maximum temperatures very likely over most parts of Northwest India during next 24 hours and rise by 2-4°C thereafter.
- ✓ No significant change in maximum temperatures very likely over most parts of Central & south peninsular India during next 2 days and rise by 2-4°C thereafter.
- ✓ Rise in maximum temperatures by 2-3°C very likely over Gujarat State during next 3 days and no significant change thereafter.
- ✓ No significant change in maximum temperatures very likely over most parts of Maharashtra during next 48 hours and gradual rise by 2-3°C thereafter.
- ✓ No significant change in maximum temperatures very likely over rest parts of the country during next 4-5 days.
- ✓ Heat Wave conditions in isolated pockets very likely over south Haryana, West Rajasthan and West Madhya Pradesh on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

Heavy Rain: 64.5 to 115.5 mm; Very Heavy Rain: 115.6 to 204.4 mm; Extremely Heavy **Rain:** >204.4 mm.

## Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:

- 1) Northwest India: Western Himalayan Region (Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand); Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi; West Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan and East Rajasthan.
- 2) Central India: West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.
- 3) East India: Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- 4) Northeast India: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
- 5) West India: Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) South India: Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
