

Press Release Date: 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2022

Time of Issue: 1315 hrs IST

Subject: (i) Intense rainfall activity likely to continue over Gujarat State, Rajasthan and adjoining Madhya Pradesh during next 2 days and gradual decrease thereafter.

(ii) Increase in rainfall activity over northern parts of India from 27<sup>th</sup> July onwards due to northward shifting of Monsoon trough.

### Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today:

Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls occurred at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh; heavy to very heavy rainfall occurred at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Gujarat Region, Madhya Maharashtra, Bihar, Konkan and Himachal Pradesh and heavy rainfall at isolated places over West Rajasthan, Odisha Tamilnadu, East Madhya Pradesh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Vidarbha, West Bengal & Sikkim, South Interior Karnataka, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Punjab (Annexure I).

#### Rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings: (Multi-hazard warning is given in Annexure II)

- > A Low Pressure Area lies over southwest Rajasthan & neighbourhood and the associated cyclonic circulation extends upto mid-tropospheric levels.
- ➤ The monsoon trough at mean sea level runs south of its normal position. It is likely to persist in the same location during next 2-3 days and very likely to shift northwards towards its normal position from 27<sup>th</sup> July for subsequent 3-4 days.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over southeast Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood in lower & middle tropospheric levels tilting southwards with height.

#### Under the influence of above systems;

- Fairly widespread/ widespread light to moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls, thunderstorm & lightning very likely over Gujarat State, Rajasthan and West Madhya Pradesh during 24<sup>th</sup> 26<sup>th</sup>; over north Konkan & adjoining ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Telangana during 24<sup>th</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
  - ✓ **Isolated extremely heavy falls** also likely over Gujarat State and southeast Madhya Pradesh on 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
  - ✓ **Isolated very heavy falls** very likely over Gujarat state & West Madhya Pradesh on 25<sup>th</sup>; East Rajasthan on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup>; West Rajasthan on 24<sup>th</sup>, over Vidarbha, north Konkan & adjoining ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra on 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.


- Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Jammu & Kashmir on 28<sup>th</sup>; Himachal Pradesh & Uttarakhand during 24<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
  - ✓ **Isolated very heavy rainfall** very likely over Himachal Pradesh & Uttarakhand on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
- Scattered to fairly widespread light to moderate rainfall over Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 24<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> and fairly widespread to widespread light to moderate rainfall with **isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over the region during 27<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
- ✓ **Isolated very heavy rainfall** very likely over Punjab on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
- Fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 24<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

# **Annexure II**



#### **EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-**

- i) Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Gujarat State and southwest Madhya Pradesh on 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.
- ii) Isolated very heavy rainfall over West Rajasthan, north Konkan, northern parts of ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra & Vidarbha on 24<sup>th</sup>; over East Rajasthan on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> and over West Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat State on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

### A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

### **B.** Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
