

Press Release Date: 03rd August, 2022 Time of Issue: 1250 hrs IST

Subject: (i) Enhanced rainfall activity likely to continue over South Peninsula during next 3 days.

(ii) Subdued rainfall activity over Central parts of the country is likely to continue till 04th August & gradually increase thereafter.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today:

Heavy to very heavy rainfall occurred at isolated places over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, South Interior Karnataka, Mizoram and Rayalaseema and heavy rainfall at isolated places over West Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, West Madhya Pradesh, Assam, Gangetic West Bengal, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Kerala, Lakshadweep and Tamil Nadu. Weather systems, rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings: (Warning Graphics in Annexure II)

- A shear zone runs roughly along 11°N over South Peninsular India in middle tropospheric levels. It is likely to shift gradually northwards during next 3-4 days.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal off south Andhra Pradesh-north Tami Nadu coasts in lower tropospheric levels.
- ➤ The western end of monsoon trough at mean sea level lies north of its normal position and its eastern end near its normal position. The monsoon trough is very likely to be near normal or south of its normal position from 05th August onwards.

> Under the influence of above system:

- Fairly widespread/widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Lakshadweep on 03rd & 04th; south Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 03rd, 06th & 07th; Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 04th-07th and over Telangana, Karnataka, and Kerala & Mahe during 03rd-07th August, 2022.
 - ✓ Isolated very heavy rainfall likely over Rayalaseema on 03rd & 04th; Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 03rd & 06th; North Interior Karnataka on 04th & 05th; Kerala & Mahe during 03rd-05th; ghat areas of Tamil Nadu on 05th and over Telangana on 03rd, 06th & 07th August, 2022.
 - ✓ Isolated extremely heavy rainfall also likely over ghat areas of Tamil Nadu on 03rd & 04th and over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 04th & 05th August, 2022.
- Fairly widespread/widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Chhattisgarh & Vidarbha during 05th-07th; Madhya Pradesh on 06th & 07th; Marathwada on 05th & 06th; Konkan & Goa during 03rd-07th and over Madhya Maharashtra during 04th-07th August, 2022.
 - ✓ Isolated/scattered very heavy rainfall also likely over Chhattisgarh on 07th and over Konkan & Goa during 05th-07th August, 2022.
- Fairly widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Gangetic West Bengal & Arunachal Pradesh on 03rd; Bihar 03rd & 04th; Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 03rd & 05th; and Odisha during 05th-07th; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 03rd-05th and over Assam & Meghalaya during 03rd-06th August, 2022.
 - ✓ Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over Odisha on 07th August, 2022.

- Fairly widespread/widespread rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Himachal Pradesh,
 Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi and East Rajasthan during next 5 days.
 - ✓ Isolated heavy rainfall likely over West Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and East Rajasthan during next 4-5 days and over Himachal Pradesh during 5th-7th; East Uttar Pradesh on 3rd and West Rajasthan on 3rd & 7th August.
 - ✓ Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over Uttarakhand on 3rd & 4th and over East Rajasthan on 6th & 07th August, 2022.



EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

i) Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over ghat areas of Tamil Nadu on 03rd & 04th and over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 04th & 05th August, 2022. 2022.

ii) Isolated very heavy rainfall over Rayalaseema on 03rd & 04th; Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 03rd & 06th; North Interior Karnataka on 04th & 05th; Kerala & Mahe during 03rd-05th; ghat areas of Tamil Nadu on 05th and over Telangana on 03rd, 06th & 07th Chhattisgarh & Odisha on 07th and over Konkan & Goa during 05th-07th August, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

- 6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
