> Press Release Date: 14th August, 2022 Time of Issue: 1315 hrs IST

Subject: (i) Depression over northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining coastal areas of West Bengal & North Odisha.

(ii) Active monsoon conditions over Central parts of India and Rajasthan during next 2-3 days and over Northwest India during 14th-15th August, 2022.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today: (Refer Annex I for activities and amounts)

Weather systems, rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings: (Warning Graphics in Annexure II)

- The Low Pressure Area over north Bay of Bengal lay as a well marked low pressure area over northwest Bay of Bengal off North Odisha & West Bengal coasts at 1730 hours IST of yesterday, the 13th August, 2022. It moved slightly west-northwestwards, concentrated into a depression and lay centered at 0830 hours IST of today, the 14th August over northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining coastal areas of West Bengal North Odisha near latitude 21.7°N and longitude 87.8°E about 10 km southeast of Digha (West Bengal) and 90 km east-northeast of Balasore (Odisha). It is very likely to move west-northwestwards and cross West Bengal & adjoining north Odisha coasts close to Digha during next 6 hours. Thereafter, it is very likely to continue to move west-northwestwards and maintain the intensity of depression during next 24 hours.
- The monsoon trough is likely to remain active during next 5 days. Its western end runs near its normal position and the eastern end to the south of its normal position. The western end of the Monsoon trough is likely to shift southwards and the eastern end northwards after 2 days.
- > The off-shore trough runs along south Gujarat and Maharashtra coasts at mean sea level.

> Under the influence of the above systems:

- Fairly widespread/Widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over East Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh and Telangana on 14th & 15th; Konkan & Goa, north Madhya Maharashtra and West Madhya Pradesh during 14th-16th; Gujarat state on 16th & 17th; Odisha during 14th- 18th August, 2022. Heavy rainfall at a few places also likely over Chhattisgarh and Odisha during next 24 hours.
 - ✓ Isolated very heavy rainfall likely over Telangana, south Jharkhand and Gangetic West Bengal on 14th; Konkan & Goa, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 15th; north Madhya Maharashtra during 14th-16th; West Madhya Pradesh on 14th & 16th; Gujarat state on 16th and over Odisha on 18th August, 2022.
 - ✓ Isolated extremely heavy rainfall also likely over Odisha, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 14th and over West Madhya Pradesh on 15th August, 2022.
- Scattered/Fairly widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over West Uttar Pradesh and Haryana on 14th; Punjab on 14th & 15th; East Uttar Pradesh during 14th-17th; Uttarakhand on 14th & 18th; Jammu division on 15th August, 2022.
 - ✓ Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over Uttarakhand on 14th; Himachal Pradesh on 14th & 15th; West Rajasthan on 16th; East Rajasthan on 14th & 16th August, 2022.
 - \checkmark Isolated extremely heavy falls also likely over East Rajasthan on 15th August, 2022.

• Fishermen Warning:



EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

i) Isolated very heavy rainfall over Uttarakhand, West Madhya Pradesh, south Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal and Telangana on 14th; Konkan & Goa, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 15th; Madhya Maharashtra during 14th-16th; Himachal Pradesh on 14th & 15th; Odisha on 18th; East Rajasthan and West Madhya Pradesh on 14th & 16th; West Rajasthan on 16th August, 2022.

ii) Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Odisha, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 14th and over East Rajasthan and West Madhya Pradesh on 15th August, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

Heavy Rain: 64.5 to 115.5 mm; Very Heavy Rain: 115.6 to 204.4 mm; Extremely Heavy Rain: >204.4 mm.

4) **Northeast India:** Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.

6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
