

Press Release Date: 22nd August, 2022 Time of Issue: 1230 hrs IST

Subject: i) Depression over Northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining southwest Uttar Pradesh.

ii) Subdued rainfall activity over northwest India during next 5 days and over central India from 24th August, 2022.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today: (Refer Annex. I)
Weather systems, rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings: (Warning Graphics in Annexure II)

- Yesterday's **Depression** over Northwest Chhattisgarh & adjoining northeast Madhya Pradesh moved nearly west-northwestwards during past 24 hours and lay centered at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 22nd August, over Northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining southwest Uttar Pradesh near latitude 24.3°N and longitude 78.4°E, about 60 km north-northwest of Sagar (Madhya Pradesh), 110 km east-southeast of Guna (Madhya Pradesh) and 120 km south of Jhansi (Uttar Pradesh). It would continue to move nearly west-northwestwards towards East Rajasthan and weaken into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area by tomorrow morning, the 23rd August, 2022. (**Annexure III).**
- > The western end of the monsoon trough at mean sea level is north of its normal position and eastern end is south of its normal position.
- > Under the influence of the above systems:
 - Widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls very likely over West Madhya Pradesh and East Rajasthan on 22nd August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy to very heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over northern parts of Gujarat Region on 22nd & 23rd; Rajasthan on 23rd August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over West Rajasthan on 22nd & 24th; East Madhya Pradesh 22nd & 26th; West Madhya Pradesh, Gangetic West Bengal, Madhya Maharashtra and Konkan & Goa on 23rd; Odisha on 23rd & 24th; Gujarat Region on 24th; Saurashtra & Kutch on 23rd; Chhattisgarh on 25th & 26thAugust, 2022.
 - o Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated **heavy falls** and **thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over Uttarakhand on 24th August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 22nd, 23rd & 25th; Arunachal Pradesh on 26th August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Coastal Karnataka on 22nd & 23rd; South Interior Karnataka on 23rd & 24th; Kerala & Mahe and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 22th -26th August, 2022.
 - Scattered light/moderate rainfall with isolated thunderstorm/lightning very likely over south Haryana, Delhi and southwest Uttar Pradesh.



EXPECTED IMPACT & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

- i) Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over West Madhya Pradesh and East Rajasthan on 22nd August, 2022.
- ii) Isolated very heavy rainfall over northern parts of Gujarat Region on 22nd & 23rd; Rajasthan on 23rd August, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
