Subject: i) Well Marked Low Pressure Area over East Rajasthan & adjoining Northwest Madhya Pradesh.

- ii) Heavy rainfall spell over East India during next 2 days.
- iii) Subdued rainfall activity over Northwest & Central India during next 5 days.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today: (Refer Annex. I) Weather systems, rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings: (Warning Graphics in Annexure II)

- Yesterday's Depression over Northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining southwest Uttar Pradesh moved west-northwestwards and weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area over East Rajasthan & adjoining northwest Madhya Pradesh at 0830 hrs IST of today.
- > The western end of the monsoon trough at mean sea level is south of its normal position and eastern end is near its normal position.
- ➤ A cyclonic circulation lies over Northeast Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood extending upto middle tropospheric levels.
- Under the influence of the above systems:
 - Widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning very likely over southwest Madhya Pradesh & south Gujarat on 23rd; southwest Rajasthan on 23rd & 24th; Chhattisgarh on 26th & 27th August, 2022
 - ✓ Heavy to very heavy rainfall also likely over north Gujarat State and south Rajasthan on 23rd August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Bihar on 23rd; East Uttar Pradesh on 24th; Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 23rd, 26th & 27th; Odisha, Jharkhand & Gangetic West Bengal on 23rd & 24th August, 2022.
 - \checkmark Heavy to very heavy rainfall also likely over Odisha on 23rd & 24th August, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Arunachal Pradesh on 23rd, 26th & 27th; Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during next 5 days.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Uttarakhand on 23rd & 24th; Jammu & Kashmir on 24th and over Himachal Pradesh on 24th & 25th August, 2022.


- Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 23rd & 24th; Tamilnadu during 23rd-26th and over Kerala & Mahe during 23rd-27th August, 2022.
 - ✓ Heavy to very heavy rainfall also likely over Kerala & Mahe on 23rd & 24th August, 2022.
- Strong Surface winds (speed reaching 20-30 kmph gusting to 40 kmph) very likely to prevail over southeast Rajasthan & adjoining West Madhya Pradesh and strong surface wind (speed reaching 15-25 kmph gusting to 35 kmph) over remaining parts of Rajasthan and adjoining north Gujarat Region and south Haryana & Delhi during next 24 hours.

IMPACT EXPECTED & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

Isolated very heavy rainfall over north Gujarat State and south Rajasthan on 23rd and over Kerala & Mahe and Odisha on 23rd & 24th August, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

Heavy Rain: 64.5 to 115.5 mm; **Very Heavy Rain:** 115.6 to 204.4 mm; **Extremely Heavy Rain:** >204.4 mm.

- 5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
