Press Release Date: 11th October, 2022 Time of Issue: 1300 hrs IST

Subject: (i) Heavy rainfall spell likely to continue over Tamilnadu & Rayalaseema during next 5 days and over Interior Karnataka during next 2 days.

(ii) Conditions are very likely to become favourable for withdrawal of southwest monsoon from some more parts of northwest & central India during next 4-5 days.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today: (Refer Annexure I)

Withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon: (Withdrawal Map in Annexure II)

- ➤ The withdrawal line of Southwest Monsoon continues to pass through Long. 79.0°E/ Lat. 31.7° N, Uttarkashi, Nazibabad, Agra, Gwalior, Ratlam, Bharuch and Long. 71.0°E / Lat. 20.3° N.
- > Conditions are very likely to become favourable for withdrawal of southwest monsoon from some more parts of northwest & central India during next 4-5 days.

Weather systems, rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings: (Warning Graphics in Annexure III)

- A **Western Disturbance** as a trough in mid & upper tropospheric westerlies runs roughly along 70°E to the north of 25°N.
- > A cyclonic circulation lies over Punjab & adjoining Haryana in lower tropospheric levels.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over Kerala in lower tropospheric levels and a trough runs from this cyclonic circulation to southwest Madhya Pradesh in lower tropospheric levels.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over north Andaman Sea in lower tropospheric levels and is very likely to move nearly westwards during next 3-4 days.
- Under the influence of above systems;
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with **isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over Madhya Maharashtra & Marathwada on 11th; Konkan & Goa on 12th; Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 11th-15th; Rayalaseema during 11th-13th & 15th; north Interior Karnataka on 11th & 12th; south interior Karnataka on 11th, 12th & 15th; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 13th & 14th and Kerala & Mahe 15th October, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and Bihar on 11th & 12th October, 2022. Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 11th October, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 11th & 12th October, 2022. Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over Arunachal Pradesh and south Assam & Meghalaya on 11th October, 2022.
 - Fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, East Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh on 11th October, 2022.



Isolated extremely heavy rainfall occurred over Arunachal Pradesh; very heavy rainfall over Assam & Meghalaya, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, East Madhya Pradesh and heavy rainfall over Punjab, West Madhya Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, South Interior Karnataka, Madhya Maharashtra, Rayalaseema, Bihar, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, West Uttar Pradesh, North Interior Karnataka and Coastal Andhra Pradesh.



IMPACT EXPECTED & ACTION SUGGESTED DUE TO-

Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh and south Assam & Meghalaya 11th October, 2022.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC)

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:

- 3) **East India:** Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- 4) **Northeast India:** Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
- 5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
