Date: 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2022 Time of Issue: 1245 hrs IST

Subject: Depression weakened into a well marked Low Pressure Area over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal off south Andhra Pradesh-north Tamil Nadu coasts.

# Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today:

- ❖ Minimum temperatures are below normal by 2-4° C over many parts of Central India.
- ❖ Light to moderate rainfall occurred at many places over south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and adjoining Rayalaseema & north Tamil Nadu.

### Weather systems, rainfall/thunderstorm Forecast & Warnings:

The Depression over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal moved westnorthwestwards and weakened into a well marked low pressure area over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal off South Andhra Pradesh-North Tamil Nadu coasts at 0830 hours IST of today, the 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2022.

It is likely to move slowly west-northwestwards and weaken further during next 24 hours.

#### Warnings:

#### (i) Rainfall (warning graphics enclosed Annexure I)

- ❖ Light to moderate rainfall at many places with isolated heavy rainfall is very likely over south coastal Andhra Pradesh on 22<sup>nd</sup> November and light to moderate rainfall at a few places over north Tamil Nadu-Puducherry during the same period.
- ❖ Light to moderate rainfall at few places is likely over North Tamil Nadu-Puducherry, South Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Rayalaseema on 23<sup>rd</sup> November.

#### (ii) Wind warning:

Squally weather wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over Westcentral and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off South Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Gulf of Mannar and adjoining North Sri Lanka coasts till evening of today and decrease gradually thereafter becoming 30-40 kmph gusting 50 kmph by 23<sup>rd</sup> November morning.

### (iii) Sea condition

**Sea condition will be rough** over Southwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off south Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Gulf of Mannar and North Sri Lanka coasts till evening of today and improve gradually thereafter becoming rough to moderate by 23<sup>rd</sup> November morning.

# (iv) Fishermen Warning (Refer annexure II)



# **Minimum Temperature Forecast**

- ❖ No significant change in minimum temperatures likely over many parts of East India during next 24 hours and fall by 2-4°C during subsequent 4 days.
- No significant change in minimum temperatures likely over rest parts of the country during next 5 days.

- 2) Central India: West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.
- 3) East India: Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- 4) Northeast India: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
- 5) West India: Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) South India: Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
