Press Release Date: 12th February, 2023 Time of Issue: 1130 hours IST

Subject: No significant weather over most parts of the country during 12th-16th February 2023

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today:

Light rainfall/snowfall observed at many places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad and at a few places over Himachal Pradesh. Thunderstorm, lightning and hailstorm occurred at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

Western Disturbance and associated likely Weather:

- ❖ A fresh feeble Western Disturbance is likely to affect Western Himalayan Region from night of 14th February, 2023. Under its influence:
 - ✓ Light isolated rainfall/snowfall with **thunderstorm & lightning** very likely at isolated places over Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad during 15th-16th February, 2023.
 - Light isolated rainfall/snowfall very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh during 12th-16th and over Assam and Nagaland on 12th February and **with thunderstorm & lightning** at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh and East Assam on 12th February, 2023.
- Strong Surface Wind (speed 25-35 kmph) very likely over some parts of plains of Northwest India during 12th-14th February, 2023.
- ❖ No significant weather very likely over rest parts of the country during next 5 days.


Minimum Temperature and Dense Fog Forecast:

No cold wave conditions and dense fog conditions very likely over the country during next 5 days.

Heavy Rain: 64.5 to 115.5 mm; **Very Heavy Rain:** 115.6 to 204.4 mm; **Extremely Heavy Rain:** >204.4 mm.

Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:

- 1) **Northwest India:** Western Himalayan Region (Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand); Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi; West Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan and East Rajasthan.
- 2) Central India: West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.
- 3) **East India:** Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- 4) **Northeast India:** Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
- 5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
