Subject:(i) Light to moderate rainfall/snowfall over Western Himalayan Region till 21st February, 2023.

(ii) Maximum temperatures are very likely to be in the range of 37-39°C over Gujarat and Konkan during next 2 days.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today:

- ❖ **Maximum temperatures** are in the range of 37-39°C over some parts of Gujarat State & southwest Rajasthan and in isolated pockets over Konkan. Maximum temperatures 26-29°C over many parts of Jammu, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, which are above normal by 6-11°C, are likely to fall from tomorrow.
- ❖ **Very Light to light rainfall** observed at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, West Bengal & Sikkim and Coastal Andhra Pradesh.
- ❖ **Dense to Very dense fog** observed in isolated pockets over Punjab, Haryana and West Uttar Pradesh in the morning hours.

Weather Forecast and Warnings (Annexure I):

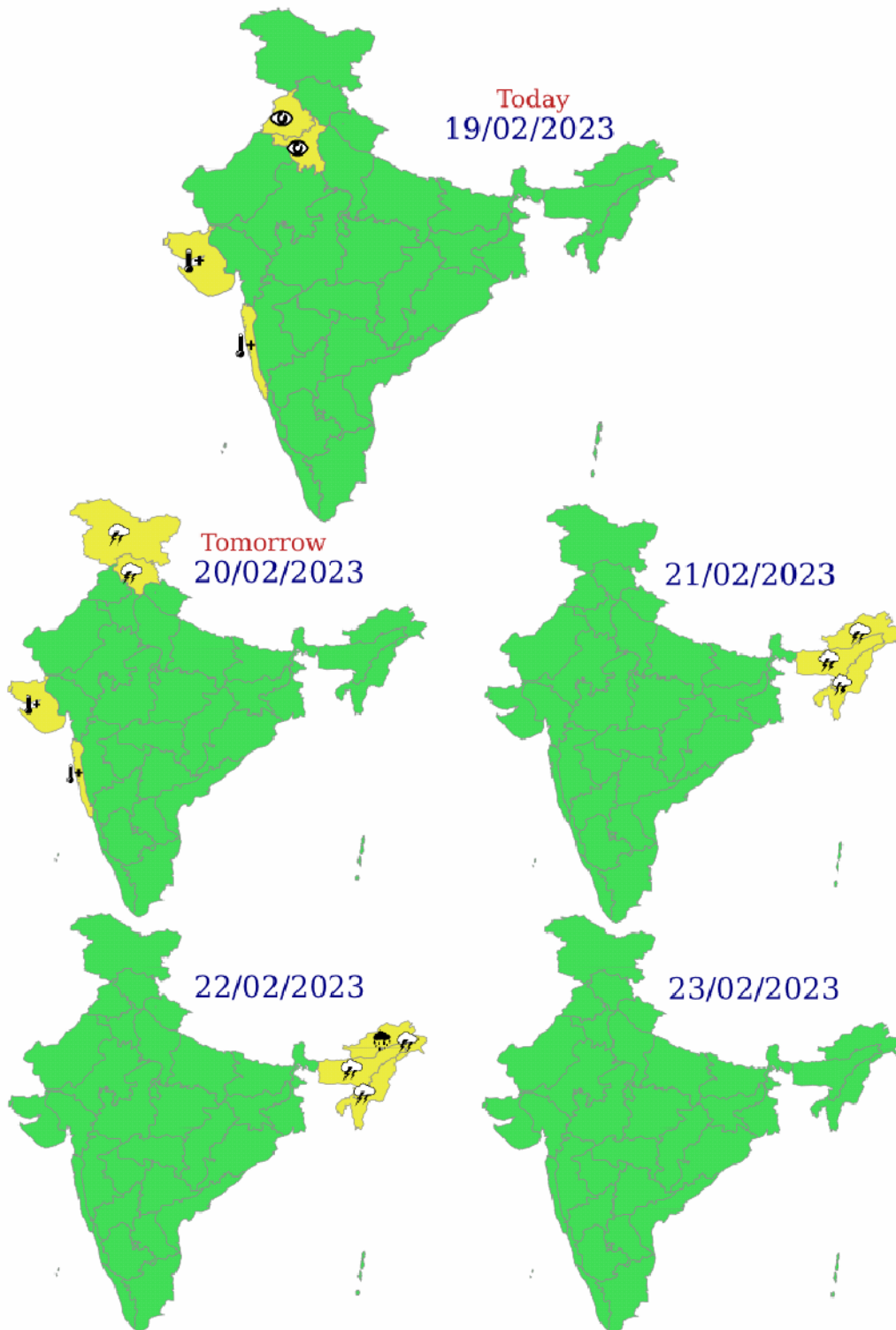
- ❖ A Western Disturbance as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies runs roughly along Long. 58°E and north of Lat. 32°N. It is likely to cause:
 - ✓ Light to moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/snowfall very likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad and isolated to scattered rainfall/snowfall over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand during 19th-21st February, 2023.
 - ✓ Light isolated rainfall/thundershowers very likely over Punjab on 20th & 21st and north Haryana on 21st February, 2023.
 - ✓ Isolated thunderstorm with lightning also likely over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad and Himachal Pradesh on 20th February, 2023.
- ❖ Light scattered to fairly widespread rainfall very likely over Arunachal Pradesh and light isolated rainfall over east Assam, Nagaland, Manipur and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 19th-23rd February, 2023. **Isolated heavy rainfall also very likely over Arunachal Pradesh on 22nd February, 2023.**
- ❖ Isolated thunderstorm with lightning very likely over Arunachal Pradesh and east Assam, Nagaland & Manipur on 21st & 22nd February, 2023.
- ❖ **No significant weather very likely over rest parts of the country during next 5 days.**

Temperature & Heat Wave Forecast:

- ❖ Maximum temperatures are very likely to be in the range of 37-39°C over many parts of Gujarat state and Maharashtra-Goa coasts during next 2 days.
- ❖ No significant change in Maximum Temperatures very likely over Gujarat and Maharashtra during next 2 days and gradual fall by 2-3°C during subsequent 3 days. No significant change in maximum Temperatures very likely over rest parts of the country during next 5 days.
- ❖ **Isolated heat wave conditions** are likely over Kutch and Konkan during next 2 days.

Heavy Rain: 64.5 to 115.5 mm; **Very Heavy Rain:** 115.6 to 204.4 mm; **Extremely Heavy Rain:** >204.4 mm.

Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:

- 1) **Northwest India:** Western Himalayan Region (Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand); Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi; West Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan and East Rajasthan.
- 2) **Central India:** West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.
- 3) **East India:** Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- 4) **Northeast India:** Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
- 5) **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- 6) **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
