> Press Release Date: 08th March, 2023 Time of Issue: 1230 hours IST

Subject: Isolated Rain/thunderstorms over East Rajasthan on 08th and over East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Odisha during 08th-10th March 2023.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today:

- Maximum Temperatures are in the range of 34-38°C over many parts of South Rajasthan, along the West Coast, Peninsular India, Odisha, and West Bengal; 29-33°C over the plains of rest parts of the Country. These are above normal by 2-4°C over many parts of the plains of Northwest India and along the west coast of India; Normal over rest parts of the country outside Central India, Interior Maharashtra and Telangana with below normal by 4-8°C.
- Light rainfall/snowfall observed at isolated places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad and Himachal Pradesh. Light/moderate rainfall/thundershowers observed at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Gujarat State, Marathwada, Madhya Maharashtra and Konkan & Goa.

Weather Forecast and Warnings (Annexure I):


- The Western Disturbance as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies now runs roughly along Long. 76°E to the north of Lat. 23°N and the induced circulation now lies over East Rajasthan & neighbourhood in lower levels.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over interior Odisha & adjoining Chhattisgarh in lower levels.
- Under their influence:
 - Isolated light rainfall with thunderstorm activity very likely over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, south Haryana, Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 8th; over East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Odisha, East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, during 08th-10th March 2023.
 - Thunderstorm with Hailstorm over Uttarakhand on 08th; Hailstorm with gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph) at isolated places over East Rajasthan on 08th March and Thunderstorm with gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Chhattisgarh on 08th and over Jharkhand during 08th-10th March, 2023.
 - Isolated light rainfall/thundershowers very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya during 08th-12th March, 2023.

Maximum Temperatures Forecast and Heat Wave warnings during next 5 days:

- Heat wave conditions very likely to occur at isolated places over Konkan & Goa on 08th & 09th March, 2023.
- Northwest India: No significant change in Maximum Temperatures likely on 08th March and rise by 2-4°C during 09th -12th March.
- Gujarat, Konkan & Goa: No significant change in Maximum Temperatures likely over Gujarat on 08th & 09th March and rise by 3-5°C during 10th -12th March; Rise by 2-3°C over Konkan & Goa during 08th -10th March.
- Central India & Interior Maharashtra: Rise in Maximum Temperatures by 4-6°C during 08th -10th March.
- Rest parts of the Country: No significant change in Maximum Temperatures likely during next 5 days except Telangana where it is likely to rise by 4-6°C during 10th -12th March.

***** Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:

- Northwest India: Western Himalayan Region (Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand); Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi; West Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan and East Rajasthan.
- Central India: West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.
- **East India:** Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Northeast India: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
- West India: Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
- South India: Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
