Press Release Date: 11th March, 2023 Time of Issue: 1315 hours IST

Subject: (i) Isolated Rain/thunderstorm activity very likely over East India during next 24 hours.

(ii) A fresh Western Disturbance likely to cause isolated/scattered rainfall & thunderstorm activity over Western Himalayan Region from the night of 12th to 14th March, 2023.

(iii) Wet spell likely over South, Central and East India during 15th-17th March, 2023.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today:

- **★ Maximum Temperatures** are in the range of 37-38°C at a few places over Saurashtra & Kutch and Coastal Karnataka; at isolated places over Konkan & Goa; 35-37°C at many places over Gujarat Region, Vidarbha and Kerala & Mahe; at a few places over West Rajasthan, Marathwada, Andhra Pradesh; at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Odisha and North Interior Karnataka and 30-35°C over rest parts of the country except Western Himalayan Region.
- ❖ Maximum Temperatures are above normal by 4-6°C at many places over Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, West Rajasthan, coastal areas of Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa and Coastal Karnataka; at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh and Assam; above normal by 2-4°C at many places over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and Bihar; at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Kerala.
- ❖ Yesterday, **heat wave conditions** observed at isolated pockets of Konkan.
- ❖ Light/Moderate rainfall/thundershowers observed at a few places over Gangetic West Bengal; at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Jharkhand, Bihar and Chhattisgarh.
- **❖ Significant amount of rainfall recorded** (≥ 1 cm): **Gangetic West Bengal:** Asansol & Bankura (dist Burdwan) 2 each, Panagarh & Luchipur (dist Burdwan) 1 each; **Sikkim:** Karbi (dist North Sikkim) 2; **Chhattisgarh:** Darbha (dist Bastar) 2, Bastar (dist Bastar) 1.
- Hailstorm observed at isolated places over Jharkhand and Gangetic West Bengal.

Weather Forecast and Warnings (Annexure I):

- ❖ The **trough** in **westerlies** now runs from north Bihar to South Interior Karnataka across Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, Telangana and North Interior Karnataka in middle tropospheric levels. Under its influence:
 - Isolated light rainfall activity with thunderstorm, lightning & gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph) very likely over West Bengal & Sikkim and Jharkhand and with thunderstorm & lightning over West Assam, Odisha and Bihar on 11th March, 2023.

- ❖ A fresh **Western Disturbance** as a trough in westerlies in middle & upper tropospheric levels runs roughly along Long. 53°E and to the north of 28°N. Under its influence:
 - Isolated to scattered rainfall with thunderstorm activity very likely over Western Himalayan Region during 12th-15th and over Rajasthan on 13th & 14th March, 2023.
 - Isolated thunderstorm with **lightning & hail** very likely over Uttarakhand on 13th & 14th and with **lightning** over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad on 12th & 13th; over Himachal Pradesh on 13th & 14th and over Rajasthan on 13th March, 2023.
- ❖ Isolated light rainfall activity with **thunderstorm**, **lightning & gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** very likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 13th-15th and with **thunderstorm & lightning** over Gujarat State, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada during 13th-15th and over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh on 14th & 15th March, 2023.
- ❖ Due to likely interaction of mid & upper tropospheric westerly trough with lower level easterly winds over central parts of Peninsular India and East India: Scattered to fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall likely over north interior Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Interior Karnataka, east Gujarat, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, West Bengal and Jharkhand during 15th-17th March, 2023.


Maximum Temperatures Forecast and Heat Wave warnings during next 5 days:

- ❖ Heat wave conditions very likely to occur in isolated pockets over Konkan and Coastal Karnataka on 11th March, 2023.
- ❖ **Northwest India:** Gradual rise in Maximum Temperatures by 2-3°C very likely during next 2 days and no significant change thereafter during subsequent 3 days.
- ❖ West India: No significant change in Maximum Temperatures very likely over Maharashtra during next 24 hours and fall by 2-3°C thereafter during subsequent 4 days.
- ❖ Central India: Gradual rise in Maximum Temperatures by 2-3°C very likely during next 3 days and fall by 2-3°C thereafter.
- ❖ **Rest parts of the Country:** No significant change in Maximum Temperatures very likely during next 5 days.

- **♦ Heavy Rain:** 64.5 to 115.5 mm; **Very Heavy Rain:** 115.6 to 204.4 mm; **Extremely Heavy Rain:** >204.4 mm.
- **Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:**
 - **Northwest India:** Western Himalayan Region (Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand); Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi; West Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan and East Rajasthan.
 - Central India: West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.
 - **East India:** Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
 - **Northeast India:** Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
 - **West India:** Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
 - South India: Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
