Press Release Date: 06<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 Time of Issue: 1230 hours IST

Subject: Light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorm & lightening over Interior Maharashtra, Telangana & Odisha on 07<sup>th</sup> April and no significant weather over Northwest and Central India during next 5 days.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today: Refer Annexure I

## Weather Forecast and Warnings (Graphics in Annexure II):

- ❖ A Western Disturbance as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies runs roughly along Long. 71°E to the north of Lat. 28°N.
- The wind discontinuity runs from cyclonic circulation over North Interior Karnataka to south Tamil Nadu in lower tropospheric levels.
- Under the influence of above synoptic features, following weather is expected:

### **Northwest & Central India:**

• No significant weather over the region during next 5 days.

#### Fast India

• No significant weather over the region during next 5 days except light isolated rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds over Odisha during next 3 days and over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 06th April. Isolated **hailstorm** also likely over Odisha and Chhattisgarh on 07th April.

### **Northeast India:**

 Light to moderate scattered/fairly widespread rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds over the region on 06th April and reduction thereafter..

### West India:

 Light/moderate isolated/scattered rainfall with isolated thunderstorm/lightning over the Maharashtra during next 5 days. Isolated hailstorm also likely over Madhya Maharashtra & Marathwada on 07th April.

### **South India:**

 Light/moderate isolated to scattered rainfall with isolated thunderstorm/lightning over Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Interior Karnataka and Kerala during next 3 days. Isolated hailstorm also likely over North Interior Karnataka on 06th and over Telangana on 06th & 07th April.

### **Maximum Temperatures Forecast during next 5 days:**


- ❖ Maximum temperatures are below normal by 2-4°C over many parts of northwest India, some parts of northeast India, Gujarat & Madhya Pradesh and near normal over remaining parts of the country. It is likely to rise gradually by 2-4°C over many parts of Northwest, Central & East India becoming near normal during next 5 days.
- No heat wave conditions likely over any part of country during next 5 days.



- \* Rainfall/thundershowers observed: at most places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad; at many places over Arunachal Pradesh; at a few places over West Rajasthan, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, East Rajasthan, west Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Sub-Himalayan west Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Interior Karnataka.
- ❖ Significant rainfall recorded (in cm): Arunachal Pradesh: Tuting (dist Upper Siang) 3, Assam & Meghalaya: Gharmura (dist Hailakandi) 5, Lakhipur (dist Cachar) 4, Amraghat (dist Cachar) 3, NMMT: Dharmanagar/ Panisagar (dist North Tripura) 4, Kolasib\_aws (dist Kolasib) 3, Kailashahar Aero (dist Unakoti) 3, Chottabekra (dist Imphal West) 3, Jiribam\_ Aws (dist Imphal East) 3, Lunglei (dist Lunglei) 3, Kolasib Agri (dist Kolasib) 3.
- \* Thunderstorm observed (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today): at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Sub-Himalayan west Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Telangana, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala and Madhya Maharashtra.
- **Duststorm observed** at isolated places over Rajasthan.
- **\Delta Hailstorm observed** at isolated places over West Rajasthan and Telangana.

Impact expected and action suggested due to isolated thunderstorm with lightning/gusty winds & Hailstorm over Telangana on 06<sup>th</sup> & 07<sup>th</sup>; North Interior Karnataka on 06<sup>th</sup> and over Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathawada on 07<sup>th</sup> April.

# Impact expected:

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

### **Action suggested:**

- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

# **Advisory for farmers:**

- Postpone harvesting of crops in Arunachal Pradesh, keep already harvested produce in a safe place or cover the heaps of already harvested produce in the field with tarpaulin sheets.
- Complete harvesting of matured crops at the earliest in Odisha, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Vidarbha and move them to safe places immediately.
- Drain out excess water from crop fields in North Eastern States.
- Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops and staking to vegetables.
- Use hail nets to protect orchards in Odisha, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Vidarbha, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana.

- ♦ Heavy Rain: 64.5 to 115.5 mm; Very Heavy Rain: 115.6 to 204.4 mm; Extremely Heavy Rain: >204.4 mm.
- **Region wise classification of meteorological Sub-Divisions:** 
  - **Northwest India:** Western Himalayan Region (Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand); Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi; West Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan and East Rajasthan.
  - Central India: West Madhya Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh.
  - East India: Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
  - Northeast India: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
  - West India: Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
  - **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
