Press Release Date: 01st May, 2023

Time of Issue: 1400 hours IST

Subject: (i) Enhanced thunderstorm activity likely to continue over the country during 01st & 02nd May. (ii)Moderate to severe thunderstorm accompanied with lightning, gusty winds & hailstorm over Northwest, Central, East and southeast peninsular India during 01st-02nd May and decrease gradually thereafter.

(iii)Isolated heavy rainfall likely over Northwest India (Jammu region, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, West Uttar Pradesh on 01st & 02nd May) and decrease thereafter (iv)Isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over South India (Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, South Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe) during 01st-03rd May and decrease thereafter.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of today: (Refer Annexure I for details)

* Rainfall/thundershowers observed: at most places over Arunachal Pradesh, West Bengal & Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Telangana, Rayalaseema; at many places over Assam & Meghalaya, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat region, Kerala, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Lakshadweep; at a few places over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Odisha, Jharkhand, Bihar, Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and at isolated places over Punjab, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Saurashtra & Kutch, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Konkan & Goa. Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Telangana and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Madhya Pradesh, East Rajasthan, West Uttar Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema, Kerala and Tamil Nadu. Hailstorm Observed at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Gangetic West Bengal, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada. Thundersquall observed at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal.

Significant Meteorological features:

- ❖ A Western Disturbance as a cyclonic circulation lies over Haryana & neighbourhood in lower to upper tropospheric levels.
- Another Western Disturbance as a cyclonic circulation lies over south Pakistan in middle tropospheric levels.
- An Induced Cyclonic Circulation lies over northwest Rajasthan in lower tropospheric levels.
- ❖ A trough/wind discontinuity runs from west Vidarbha to South Interior Karnataka in lower tropospheric levels.

Forecast and warning for next 5 days

Northwest India:

- ❖ Light to moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/snowfall with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds (wind speed 30-50 kmph) very likely over Northwest India during next 2 days and gradually reduction thereafter.
- ❖ Hailstorm activity very likely at isolated places over Uttarakhand during next 5 days; over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Himachal Pradesh & Uttar Pradesh during 01st &02nd May; over East Rajasthan on 01st May.
- **Thundersquall (wind speed 50-60 kmph)** very likely over Uttarakhand on 02nd & 03rd May.
- ❖ Heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Jammu division, Himachal Pradesh & Uttarakhand on 01st & 02nd May; Haryana, West Uttar Pradesh on 01st May over Punjab on 02nd May.
- ❖ **Duststorm** very likely at isolated places over West Rajasthan on 04th May.

Central India:

- ❖ Scattered/fairly widespread rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds (40-50 kmph) very likely over the region during next 3 days(1-3 May) and reduction thereafter.
- Hailstorm very likely at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh today 1 May and over East Madhya Pradesh on 01st & 02nd May.

East India:

- Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread **rainfall** with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds very likely over the region during next 3 days and gradual reduction thereafter.
- ❖ Hailstorm very likely at isolated places over Jharkhand on 01st May and Gangetic West Bengal on 01st & 03rd May.
- ❖ Heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 01st-02nd May and over Odisha on 01st May.

South India:

- Scattered/fairly widespread rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds (40-50 kmph) very likely over the region during next 4 days.
- ❖ Heavy to very Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema & Tamil Nadu on 01st May and isolated heavy rainfall over South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Kerala & Tamil Nadu during 01st-03rd May.
- **❖ Hailstorm** very likely at isolated places over Telangana on 01st & 02nd May.

Northeast India:

- ❖ Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds very likely over the region during next 5 days.
- ❖ Heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya during 01st-04th May.

West India:

- Light isolated rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning very likely over the region during next 5 days.
- ❖ Hailstorm activity very likely at isolated places over Marathawada on 01st & 02nd May.

Maximum Temperatures Forecast and Heat Wave Warnings (Graphics in Annexure II):

- ❖ Maximum temperatures are very likely to be below normal to near normal during next 5 days.
- ❖ No Heat wave conditions likely over any part of India during next 5 days.

Impact expected and action suggested due to thunderstorm with lightning/gusty winds & Hailstorm:

- 01st May: Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, West Bengal & Sikkim, Jharkhand, Odisha, Marathawada, Telangana
- 02nd May: Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Eats Madhya Pradesh, Marathawada
- 03rd May: Gangetic West Bengal

Impact expected:

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

Action suggested:

- \$ Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- ❖ Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

Agromet advisories for thunderstorms/lightning/gusty winds/ Hailstorm likely over various parts of the country:


- Keep Postpone harvesting of green gram and black gram in Tamilnadu; wheat in Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.
- ❖ Complete harvesting of matured rice in Kerala, Odisha and Interior Karnataka during clear weather.
- Continue harvesting of matured maize, fruits (grapes, pomegranate, mango etc.), onion and other vegetables in Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Vidarbha during clear weather.
- ❖ Keep the harvested produce of crops in safe places.
- ❖ Drain out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, West Uttar Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Sub Himalayan West Bengal, Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, South Interior Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.
- Use hail nets to protect orchards in Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand and Telangana.
- ❖ Provide mechanical support to horticultural crops and staking to vegetables.



Observations: (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today):

- * Rainfall/thundershowers observed: at most places over Arunachal Pradesh, West Bengal & Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Telangana, Rayalaseema; at many places over Assam & Meghalaya, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat region, Kerala, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Lakshadweep; at a few places over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Odisha, Jharkhand, Bihar, Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and at isolated places over Punjab, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Saurashtra & Kutch, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Konkan & Goa. Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Madhya Pradesh, East Rajasthan, West Uttar Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema, Kerala and Tamil Nadu. Hailstorm Observed at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Gangetic West Bengal, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada. Thundersquall observed at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal.
- ❖ Significant rainfall recorded(in cm): Tamil Nadu: Chamraj Estate (dist Nilgiris), Coonoor (dist Nilgiris), Coonoor PTO (dist Nilgiris), Valparai PTO (dist Coimbatore) 7 each, Coastal Andhra Pradesh: Palnadu: Macherla-10, B. R Ambedkar Konaseema: Amalapuram-7, Eluru: Koyyalgudem-7, Telangana: Palakurthi (dist Jangaon) 13, Devaruppal (dist Jangaon) 12, Velagatoor (dist Jagtial) 9, Dharmasagar (dist Hanumakonda) 9, Zaffergadh (dist Jangaon) 9, Karimnagar (dist Karimnagar) 9, Rayalaseema: YSR ditric-10, Kurnool-7, Nandyal-6, , Kerala: Ottappalam (Palakkad district) 9, Kurudamannil (Pathanamthitta district) 7, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim: North Sikkim-7, Darzeeling-5, Himchal Prdaesh: Kangra, Shimla-5 each, Odisha: Kandhamal-8, Uttarakhand: Nainital-5, Punjab: Patti (dist Tarn Taran) 5, East Rajasthan: Bhilwara: Shahpura-7, Madhya Pradesh: Datia-aws (dist Datia) 8, Sausar (dist Chindwara) 7, Khajuraho Aero (dist Chhatarpur) 5, West Uttar Pradesh: Sambhal, Bareilly-7 each, Moradabad-6, Bulandshahar-5, Arunachal Pradesh: Mukto_arg (dist Tawang) 5, Tawang_ Aws (dist Tawang) 5, Vidarbha: Nagbhir (dist Chandrapur) 6.

 - East India: Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim; Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
 - Northeast India: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.
 - West India: Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
 - **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
