**Subject: i) Active monsoon conditions likely to continue over Northwest, Central & West India during next 3 days.**

**ii) Southwest monsoon is likely to advance into remaining parts of the country during next 2-3 days.**

**Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I):**

**Advance of Southwest Monsoon (Annexure II)**

- ❖ The Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into remaining parts of north Arabian Sea and some more parts of Rajasthan today, the 28th June.
- ❖ The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) now passes through Lat. 29.4°N/ Long. 70.7°E, Bikaner, Narnaul, Firozpur and Lat. 32.5°N/ Long. 72.5°E.
- ❖ Conditions are favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into remaining parts of the country (i.e. remaining parts of Rajasthan and Haryana and Punjab) during next 2-3 days.

**Significant Weather features, Forecast and Warning during next 5 days: (Annexure III)**

- ❖ The **Low Pressure Area** now lies over northeast Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards towards northwest Madhya Pradesh during next 2 days.
- ❖ An east-west trough runs from northwest Rajasthan to Northeast Bay of Bengal across the centre of Low Pressure Area in lower tropospheric levels.
- ❖ The off-shore trough at mean sea level runs from Maharashtra coast to Kerala coast.
- ❖ A cyclonic circulation lies over south Gujarat coast & neighbourhood in middle tropospheric levels.

**Weather Forecast and Warning due to strengthening of the Southwest Monsoon Flow over the Indian subcontinent:**

**Northwest India:**

- ❖ Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy rainfall** very likely over Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana during next 3 days. Isolated **Heavy to Very Heavy rainfall** very likely over Himachal Pradesh on 28<sup>th</sup>; East Rajasthan during 28<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> June and Uttarakhand on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> June.

### Central India:

- ❖ Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy falls** with thunderstorm & lightning over Madhya Pradesh during next 3 days and over Chhattisgarh & Vidarbha during next 24 hours. Isolated **very heavy rainfall** very likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> and East Madhya Pradesh on 28<sup>th</sup> June.

### West India:

- ❖ Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with **isolated Heavy to very Heavy rainfall** is very likely over Konkan & Goa, Gujarat State and Ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra during next 5 days. Isolated **extremely heavy rainfall** also very likely over Konkan and Gujarat region on 28<sup>th</sup> June.

### East & adjoining Northeast India:

- ❖ Fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated **Heavy to Very Heavy falls** very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh during next 5 days. Isolated **heavy rainfall** also likely over Jharkhand, Odisha, Gangetic West Bengal on 28<sup>th</sup> and Bihar during 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> June.

### South India:


- ❖ Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall very likely over Kerala & Mahe, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka during next 5 days. **Isolated heavy rainfall** also likely over Coastal Karnataka during next 5 days; Kerala on 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> June & 02<sup>nd</sup> July, South Interior Karnataka on 28<sup>th</sup> June & 02<sup>nd</sup> July. Isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Coastal Karnataka on 28<sup>th</sup> June.





## Weather Observations: (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today):

- ❖ **Rainfall/thundershowers observed** (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today): **at most places** over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand, East Madhya Pradesh, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep; **at many places** over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Odisha, Bihar, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat state, Telangana, South Interior Karnataka; **at a few places** over West Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, North Interior Karnataka.
- ❖ **Heavy Rainfall observed:** **Extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Gangetic West Bengal; **Heavy to Very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Konkan & Goa, Coastal Karnataka, Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, Kerala & Mahe, Gujarat Region; **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan, West Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha and Jharkhand.

### Agromet advisories for rainfall, thunderstorms likely over various parts of the country:

- Drain out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Sikkim, Odisha, Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Vidarbha, Gujarat, Kerala, Coastal and South Interior Karnataka and North Eastern States.
- Provide staking to vegetables.

**Impact & Action Suggested due to extremely heavy/very heavy rainfall** over West Madhya Pradesh during 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>; East Madhya Pradesh on 28<sup>th</sup>; Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya during 28<sup>th</sup> June-02<sup>nd</sup> July; Uttarakhand on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>; Himachal Pradesh on 28th; Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Gujarat Region during 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup>; Arunachal Pradesh on 30<sup>th</sup> June-02<sup>nd</sup> July.

#### **A. Impact Expected**

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutch roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).

#### **B. Action Suggested**

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
