Subject: A fresh spell of heavy to very heavy rainfall likely over south Peninsular India from 02nd July, 2023.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I):

Advance of Southwest Monsoon (Annexure II)

- ❖ Conditions are favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into remaining parts of the country (i.e. remaining parts of Rajasthan and Haryana and Punjab) during next 2 days.

Significant Weather features, Forecast and Warning during next 5 days: (Annexure III)

- ❖ A cyclonic circulation lies over central parts of south Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood in lower & middle levels.
- ❖ An east-west trough runs from northwest Rajasthan to Nagaland and another from the cyclonic circulation over central parts of south Uttar Pradesh to Northeast Arabian Sea in lower levels.
- ❖ The off-shore trough at mean sea level runs from Maharashtra coast to Kerala coast.
- ❖ A cyclonic circulation lies over Southeast Bay of Bengal in middle levels.

Weather Forecast and Warning:

Northwest India: Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall very likely to continue over the region during next 2 days. Isolated **Heavy rainfall** very likely over Uttarakhand on 30th June, 03rd & 04th July; West Rajasthan, West Uttar Pradesh on 30th June, East Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan on 30th June & 01st July.

Isolated Heavy to very Heavy rainfall is very likely over East Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan on 30th June.

Central India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy falls very likely** over Madhya Pradesh during next 2 days.

West India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with **isolated Heavy to very Heavy rainfall** is very likely over Konkan & Goa and Ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra during next 5 days and Gujarat State during next 2 days.

East & adjoining Northeast India: Fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated **Heavy to Very Heavy falls** very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh during next 5 days. Isolated **heavy rainfall** also likely over Gangetic West Bengal on 30th June & 03rd July; Jharkhand on 03rd and Odisha on 03rd & 04th July.


South India: Light/moderate scattered to widespread rainfall very likely over Kerala & Mahe, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka during next 5 days. **Isolated heavy rainfall** also likely over Coastal Karnataka & Kerala during next 5 days; South Interior Karnataka & Tamil Nadu during 02nd-04th July; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Rayalaseema on 03rd & 04th July; Telangana on 04th July. Isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Coastal Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu on 03rd & 04th July.





Weather Observations: (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today):

- **Rainfall/thundershowers observed** (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today): **at most places** over Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, East Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Bihar, Uttarakhand, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Konkan & Goa, Vidarbha, South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep; **at many places** over Assam & Meghalaya, Gangetic West Bengal, West Uttar Pradesh, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra, North Interior Karnataka; **at a few places** over Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, West Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh.
- **Heavy Rainfall observed: Heavy to Very heavy with Extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Gujarat state, Meghalaya; **Heavy to Very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana and **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Tripura and Coastal Karnataka.

Agromet advisories for rainfall, thunderstorms likely over various parts of the country:

- Drain out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, West Bengal, Sikkim, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Gujarat, Kerala, Coastal Karnataka and North Eastern States.
- Provide staking to vegetables.

Impact & Action Suggested due to extremely heavy/very heavy rainfall over Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya during 29th June-03rd July; Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Gujarat, East Rajasthan, Bihar on 30th; Arunachal Pradesh during 02nd-04th July.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
