# Subject: Extremely heavy rainfall over Himachal, Uttarakhand and adjoining areas of Punjab & Haryana today, the 09<sup>th</sup> July and decrease significantly thereafter.

## Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I):

## Significant Weather features, Forecast and Warning during next 5 days: (Annexure II)

- The monsoon trough is active with its western end to the south of its normal position and eastern end to the north of its normal position.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over central Rajasthan in lower tropospheric levels.
- A Western Disturbance in lower & mid-tropospheric westerlies runs from north Pakistan to northeast Arabian Sea.
- The off-shore trough at mean sea level runs from south Gujarat coast to north Kerala coast.

## Weather Forecast and Warning:

**Northwest India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** is very likely Western Himalayan Region, Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi, Rajasthan during 09<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> and Uttar Pradesh during next 5 days. **Isolated extremely heavy rainfall also very likely Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and adjoining districts of Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh on 09<sup>th</sup> July. Isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall likely over Uttar Pradesh during 10<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> July.** 

**West India:** Light/moderate widespread rainfall with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely to continue over Konkan & Goa, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra and Gujarat state during next 3 days and decrease thereafter.

**East & adjoining Northeast India**: Fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam- & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur during next 5 days. Isolated **heavy rainfall** likely over Odisha during next 5 days; Jharkhand during 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>; Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 09<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> July and **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** over Bihar during 11<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> July.

**Central India**: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with **isolated heavy rainfall** is very likely over the region during next 5 days. **Isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall likely over West Madhya Pradesh during 09<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> July.** 

**South India:** Light/moderate widespread rainfall with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely to over Coastal Karnataka and Kerala during next 5 days.

## No significant weather likely over rest parts of the country.





## Agromet advisories for rainfall, thunderstorms likely over various parts of the country:

- Drain out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Sub Himalayan West Bengal & amp; Sikkim, Odisha, Madya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Konkan & amp; Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Coastal and South Interior Karnataka and North Eastern States.
- Postpone transplanting of rice in Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.
- Postpone sowing of maize, kharif pulses and vegetables in Jammu & Kashmir; maize, soybean and vegetables in Uttarakhand.
- Provide staking to vegetables.

**Impact & Action Suggested due to very heavy/extremely heavy rainfall** and likely Flash Flood (for Flash Flood details, refer below)

**09th July**: Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, north Punjab, north Haryana-Chandigarh, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, West Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Gujarat State, rest parts of Punjab & Haryana-Chandigarh-Delhi **10th July**: Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Gujarat Region, Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim;

**11th July**: Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Bihar;

**12th July**: Uttarakhand, Assam & Meghalaya, Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar and East Uttar Pradesh

**13th July**: East Uttar Pradesh, Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, Konkan & Goa and Assam & Meghalaya

## A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).

## **B. Action Suggested**

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

Moderate to High flash flood threat likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 6 hours.

Har - Chd & Delhi - Panchkula district. Himachal Pradesh - Chamba, Hamirpur, Kangra, Kullu, Mandi, Shimla, Sirmaur, Solan and Una districts.




# Persistent Flash Flood Threat (PFFT) till 1730 IST of 09-07-2023 :

Moderate flash flood threat likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 6 hours.

Uttarakhand - Almora, Bageshwar, Dehradun, Nanital, Pauri Garhwal and Pithoragarh districts.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 6 hours.





Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Himachal Pradesh & adjoining Jammu & Kashmir and Uttarakhand & adjoining West Uttar Pradesh Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
