Press Release Date: 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 Time of Issue: 1230 hours IST

Subject: 1) A Low Pressure Area lies over Northwest & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal.

2) Active monsoon conditions over east India during 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>; over central India during 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> and west India during 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2023.

## Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I): Significant Weather features:

- ❖ Under the influence of cyclonic circulation over central & adjoining north Bay of Bengal, a **Low Pressure Area** has formed today morning and now it lies over Northwest & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal. It is likely to become more marked during next 24 hours and move across Odisha and Chhattisgarh during next 3 days.
- ❖ A trough runs from central parts of south Uttar Pradesh to cyclonic circulation associated with the **Low Pressure Area** over Northwest & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal across Chhattisgarh and Odisha in lower & middle tropospheric levels.
- ❖ The Monsoon Trough lies to the south of its normal position.

### Weather Forecast and Warnings: (Annexure II)

**Northwest India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm with isolated **heavy falls** very likely over Uttarakhand during 14<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>; southwest Uttar Pradesh on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>; southeast Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan during 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> September.

**Central India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha during 13<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>; West Madhya Pradesh during 14<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> and Chhattisgarh during 13<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> September.

Isolated very heavy rainfall is also very likely over south Chhattisgarh on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup>; East Madhya Pradesh on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>; West Madhya Pradesh on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>; Vidarbha during 14<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> September.

**East India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over Odisha during 13<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>; Jharkhand on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>; over Gangetic West Bengal on 13<sup>th</sup> &14<sup>th</sup> and over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 15<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup> September. **Isolated Extremely heavy rainfall also very likely over Odisha on 13<sup>th</sup> September and very heavy rainfall on 14<sup>th</sup> September.** 

**South India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy rainfall** very likely over Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 13<sup>th</sup> and over Telangana during 13<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> September.

**West India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over Konkan & Goa, ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada during 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> September; Gujarat Region on 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> September.

**Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over** ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada on 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> September.

**Northeast India:** Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/thunderstorm with isolated **heavy rainfall** activity very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> September.




### Rainfall observations: (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today, the 13th September, 2023):

**Impact & Action Suggested due to very heavy rainfall** over Odisha, Chhattisgarh on 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>; ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada on 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>; East Madhya Pradesh on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>; West Madhya Pradesh on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>; Vidarbha during 14<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> September.

#### **Impact expected:**

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- · Loose objects may fly.

#### **Action suggested:**

- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

  - West India: Gujarat Region, Saurashtra & Kutch, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada.
  - **South India:** Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Coastal Karnataka, North Interior Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.
