Press Release Date: 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 Time of Issue: 1300 hours IST

Subject: 1) A Low Pressure Area has formed over Northwest Bay of Bengal off West Bengal-Odisha coasts. It is likely to move west-northwestwards across North Odisha & South Jharkhand during next 2 days. Under its influence, heavy to very heavy rainfall likely over East India during next 3 days.

2) Isolated extremely heavy rainfall very likely to continue over Saurashtra & Kutch today, the 19 Sept and decrease thereafter.

# Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I): For Flash Flood Guidance Map (Annexure III) Significant Weather features:

- ❖ Under the influence of the cyclonic circulation over Northwest & adjoining Central Bay of Bengal, a Low Pressure Area has formed over Northwest Bay of Bengal off West Bengal-Odisha coasts. Associated cyclonic circulation extends upto middle tropospheric levels tilting southwest-wards with height. It is likely to move west-northwestwards across North Odisha & South Jharkhand during next 2 days.
- ❖ A cyclonic circulation lies over southwest Rajasthan and extends upto middle tropospheric levels.
- ❖ The Monsoon Trough lies south to its normal position and passes through Jaisalmer, Kota, Guna, Siddhi, Ranchi and the centre of **Low Pressure Area** over Northwest Bay of Bengal off West Bengal-Odisha coasts and thence southeastwards to Eastcentral Bay of Bengal.

# Weather Forecast and Warnings: (Annexure II)

**West India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely over Gujarat state, north Konkan and ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra on 19<sup>th</sup> September.

**❖** Isolated extremely heavy rainfall very likely over Saurashtra & Kutch on 19<sup>th</sup> September.

**East India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Jharkhand during 19<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>; Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> and Bihar during 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> September.

Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over Odisha during 19th-21st September.

**Northwest India:** Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/thunderstorm with isolated **heavy falls** very likely over Punjab and Himachal Pradesh on 19<sup>th</sup> September.

**Northeast India:** Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/thunderstorm with isolated **heavy rainfall** activity very likely over Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 19<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> and over Arunachal Pradesh during 20<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> September.

Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over Nagaland, Manipur on 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> and over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> September.

**Central India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over Chhattisgarh during 19<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>; East Madhya Pradesh during 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup>; Vidarbha and West Madhya Pradesh on 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> September.

**South India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy rainfall** very likely over Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> and interior Tamil Nadu, Kerala on 19<sup>th</sup> September.





**Impact & Action Suggested due to very heavy rainfall/extremely heavy falls** over Saurashtra & Kutch on 19<sup>th</sup> and over Odisha during 19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> September.

### Impact expected:

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

#### **Action suggested:**


- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

### **Annexure III**

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 20-09-2023 :

Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Saurashtra & Kutch adjoining Gujarat Region Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

- **♦ Heavy Rain:** 64.5 to 115.5 mm; **Very Heavy Rain:** 115.6 to 204.4 mm; **Extremely Heavy Rain:** >204.4mm.
