Press Release Date: 21st September, 2023 Time of Issue: 1345 hours IST

Subject: 1) Heavy to very heavy rainfall likely to continue over Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha on 21st, over Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim on 21st & 22nd and over northeast India during 21st-23rd September.

- 2) Reduced rainfall activity likely to continue over northwest and adjoining westcentral India during next 5 days. However, the conditions for commencement of withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon rainfall from parts of West Rajasthan is likely to develop towards the end of the forecast period.
- 3) Thunderstorm accompanied with cloud-to-ground lightning very likely over Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh during 21st-22nd September.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I): For Flash Flod Guidance Map (Annexure III)
Significant Weather features:

- ❖ Yesterday's **Low Pressure Area now lies over Southeast Jharkhand & neighbourhood**. Associated cyclonic circulation extends upto middle tropospheric levels tilting south-westwards with height.
- ❖ A trough runs from cyclonic circulation associated with the **Low Pressure Area** over southeast Jharkhand to southwest Uttar Pradesh in lower tropospheric levels.
- ❖ The Monsoon Trough currently lies south to its normal position. It is likely to gradually shift northwards during the next 2-3 days.

Weather Forecast and Warnings: (Annexure II)

East India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 21st-24th; Bihar during 21st-23rd; Odisha, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal on 21st & 22nd and Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 23rd-25th September.

Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 21^{st} - 23^{rd} ; Odisha, Jharkhand on 21^{st} and Bihar on 21^{st} & 22^{nd} September.

Isolated extremely heavy rainfall very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on $21^{\rm st}$ September.

Northeast India: Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/thunderstorm with isolated **heavy to very heavy rainfall** activity very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya,

Nagaland & Manipur during 21st-24th September.

Isolated extremely heavy rainfall very likely over Assam & Meghalaya on 21st September.

Central India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh during 21st-23rd, West Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha on 21st & 22nd September.

Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh on 21^{st} September.

South India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy rainfall** very likely over Kerala, Tamil Nadu on 21st & 22nd; Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Telangana on 21st September.

Northwest India: Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/thunderstorm with isolated **heavy falls** very likely over Uttarakhand on 21st and East Uttar Pradesh on 21st & 22nd September. **West India:** Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over north Konkan on 21st, 24th & 25th; Madhya Maharashtra and Marathawada on 21st & 22nd September.

Isolated to scattered light/moderate rainfall likely over rest parts of the country during next 5 days.


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

Annexure II





Impact & Action Suggested due to very heavy rainfall over Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Assam & Meghalaya on 21st and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 21st-23rd; Bihar on 21st & 22nd September.

A. Impact Expected

- Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides in the hilly areas.
- ❖ Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- ❖ It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- ❖ Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.

Avoid staying in vulnerable structure

Impact expected and action suggested due to isolated thunderstorm with lightning over Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh on 21st & 22nd September.

Impact expected:

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

Action suggested:


- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

Annexure III

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 22-09-2023 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Jharkhand, North Chhattisgarh & adjoining East Madhya Pradesh Met Sub-divisions during next hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 22-09-2023 :


Light to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of SHWB & Sikkim Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.


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24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 22-09-2023 :
