Subject: 1) Heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely to continue over Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, north Odisha during next 3 days and over Northeast India during next 4 days.

2) Today, the Southwest Monsoon has withdrawn from some more parts of Uttarakhand, West Uttar Pradesh, & West Madhya Pradesh; remaining parts of Rajasthan, and some parts of Gujarat state.

Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I): Withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon: (Annexure III)

- ✓ The line of withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon now passes through Gulmarg, Dharamshala, Mukteshwar, Pilibhit, Orai, Ashoknagar, Indore, Baroda and Porbandar.
- ✓ Today, the Southwest Monsoon has withdrawn from some more parts of Uttarakhand, West Uttar Pradesh, & West Madhya Pradesh; remaining parts of Rajasthan, and some parts of Gujarat state.
- ✓ Conditions are becoming favourable for further withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon from remaining parts of Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Uttar Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat state; some parts of East Uttar Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra during next 2-3 days.

Significant Weather features:

❖ Yesterday's **Low Pressure Area** now lies over southeast Jharkhand & neighbourhood. It is very likely to move nearly eastwards during next 2-3 days across West Bengal, causing light/moderate rainfall over many parts with **isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall** over Bihar, West Bengal & Sikkim, Jharkhand and north Odisha on 03rd & 04th October and over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Mizoram & Tripura during 04th-06th October, 2023.

Weather Forecast and Warnings: (Annexure II)

East India: Rainfall warning: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Jharkhand and north Odisha on 03^{rd} & 04^{th} ; over Bihar and West Bengal & Sikkim during 03^{rd} to 05^{th} ; over Andaman & Nicobar Islands during 03^{rd} to 07^{th} October. Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over Jharkhand and north Odisha on 03^{rd} and West Bengal & Sikkim on 03^{rd} & 04^{th} October.

Central India: Light/moderate scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over north Chhattisgarh on 03rd October.

Northeast India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall/thunderstorm & lightning with **isolated heavy rainfall** very likely over Assam & Meghalaya during 03^{rd} - 07^{th} ; Arunachal Pradesh during 03^{rd} - 06^{th} and over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 03^{rd} - 05^{th} October.

Northwest India: Light/moderate scattered rainfall with isolated **heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely over southeast Uttar Pradesh on 03rd October. Isolated light rainfall also likely over Western Himalayan Region during next 24 hours.

South India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated **heavy rainfall** very likely over ghat areas of Tamil Nadu and Kerala on 03^{rd} October.

Isolated very heavy rainfall very likely over south Kerala today.

West India: No significant weather over the region during next 5 days.





- ➤ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Odisha, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, East Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Assam & Meghalaya and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura and Kerala.

Impact & Action Suggested due to very heavy rainfall over north Odisha, Jharkhand, East Uttar Pradesh and south Kerala on 03rd; over West Bengal & Sikkim on 03rd & 04th, Assam & Meghalaya during 04th-06th and Arunachal Pradesh on 05th October, 2023.


A. Impact Expected

- ❖ Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.
- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- Localized Landslides/Mudslides in the hilly areas.
- ❖ Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.
- ❖ It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).

B. Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- ❖ Avoid staying in vulnerable structure




Flash Flood Guidance Map

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 04-10-2023 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of northern parts of Chhattisgarh, northern parts of Odisha adjoining Gangetic West Bengal and SHWB & Sikkim Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

- ♦ Heavy Rain: 64.5 to 115.5 mm; Very Heavy Rain: 115.6 to 204.4 mm; Extremely Heavy Rain: >204.4 mm.
