Subject: A fresh spell of rainfall with isolated heavy falls likely over south Peninsular India from 08th to 10th December.

Realized weather during past 24 hours till 0830 hours IST of today: (Refer Annexure I)

Weather systems:

- Yesterday's cyclonic circulation over Southeast Arabian Sea & neighbourhood now lies over Southeast Arabian Sea & adjoining Maldives area in lower & middle tropospheric levels.
- A fresh feeble Western Disturbance as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies runs roughly along Long. 65°E to the north of Lat. 34°N.
- Another fresh feeble Western Disturbance is likely to affect Western Himalayan Region from 11th December.

Rainfall Warning (graphics in Annexure II):

- Light to moderate rainfall at some places with isolated thunderstorm & lightning very likely over Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep during next 4-5 days.
- Isolated **heavy rainfall** also very likely over Kerala during 08th-10th; over Tamil Nadu on 08th & 09th and over Lakshadweep on 08th December.
- **Hailstorm** also likely at isolated places over Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim on 12th December.

Dense fog warning:

- **Dense fog** during morning hours very likely in isolated pockets over Punjab, Haryana and East Uttar Pradesh on 09th; over Bihar on 09th & 10th and over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 09th - 11th December.

Minimum Temperatures Forecast:


- Gradual fall in Minimum Temperatures by about 2-4°C are very likely over Northwest, Central & East India during next 3 days and no significant change thereafter.
- No significant change in Minimum Temperatures over rest parts of the country during next 4-5 days.

Realized weather during past 24 hours till 0830 hours IST of today (08.12.2023):


- **Heavy rainfall** observed at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Rayalaseema, Tamil Nadu and Kerala.
- Significant Rainfall Amount:
 - **Tamil Nadu:** Periyanaickenpalayam (dist Coimbatore), Pillur Dam Mettupalayam (dist Coimbatore) 9 each, Kil Kotagiri Estate (dist The Nilgiris), Rajapalayam (dist Virudhunagar), Siruvani Adivaram (dist Coimbatore) 7 each;
 - **Kerala:** Seethathode Aws (dist Pathanamthitta) 10, Neryamangalam Arg (dist Ernakulam) 7;
 - **Raylaseema:** Tanakal (dist Sri Sathyasai District) 7.
 - **Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura:** Champai Agri (dist Champhai) 8, Lengpui (dist Aizawl) 8, Serchip_Aws (dist Serchhip) 7, Lunglei (dist Lunglei) 7






